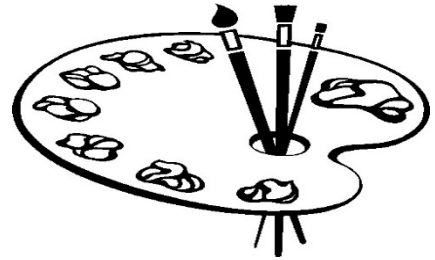
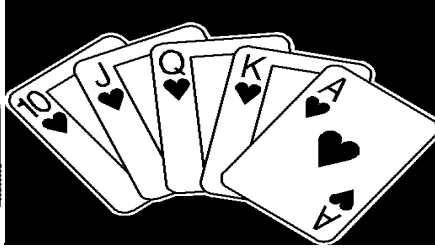
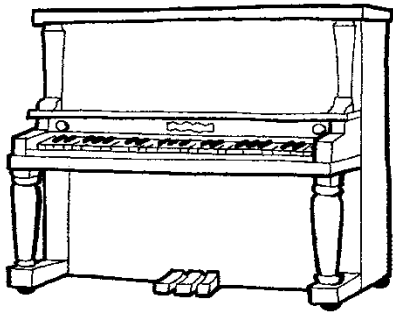


N.C. ASSISTED LIVING ACTIVITY PROFESSIONAL TRAINING CLASS

Sponsored by The Coalition of Resident Councils (The CORC) and is approved by the Division of Health Services Regulation (DHSR), Adult Care Licensure Section.

This course meets the administrative code 10A NCAC 13F .0404 (2)

“Qualifications of Activity Director” for Adult Care Homes in NC.



The course will meet on **TUESDAYS** over the course of 5 months. Class time is 1pm to 4:15pm. Week #1, the class will meet for one (1) hour only from 1:00pm to 2:00pm for class orientation. A ZOOM meeting format will be utilized. Minimal travel required locally. You can take the class right on your computer. You need to have a camera and microphone on your computer in order to participate. These classes are “live” sessions, so you do need to be in class during the class time.

Course dates are: **TUESDAYS** from 1:00pm to 2:00pm for Orientation and the Course requirements. Orientation is **mandatory** on August 30, 2022. Class will meet for 3.0 hours on **TUESDAYS** beginning September 6, 2022 and will end on January 24, 2023. Classes will **not** be held on: November 1, November 22, December 20, December 27, 2022

Course content is 85+ Hours consisting of the following:

- 52 hours virtual class time
- 33 + hours practicum/clinical/homework/class project
- Final exam
